

AFFIDAVIT OF JUDY WICKER

I, Judy Wicker, do solemnly swear to the following facts:

1. On July 28, 2008, I met with Assistant Attorneys General Clay Crenshaw and Jasper Roberts. They informed me that an inmate named Bobby Gilbert alleged that we had a sexual relationship for 4-5 weeks in January to February 1982 and that we engaged in intercourse approximately twelve times. In addition, I was informed that Gilbert alleged that we engaged in intercourse on the morning of the murder, February 1, 1982. Finally, I was informed that Gilbert implied that he, and not Tommy Arthur, murdered Troy Wicker.

2. None of Gilbert's allegations are true. I do not know anyone named Bobby Gilbert. I have never had any relationship, much less a sexual relationship, with anyone named Bobby Gilbert. Furthermore, during my discussions with Assistant Attorneys General Crenshaw and Roberts, they showed me a picture of Bobby Gilbert from Gilbert's Alabama Department of Corrections' file. See Exhibit 1 (photograph of Gilbert). Crenshaw and Roberts also informed me, based on information provided to them by Gilbert, that in February of 1982 Gilbert had a tattoo of the word "love" on his left hand spelled out on his fingers, he had a tattoo of a skull that was

smoking a cigarette on his upper right arm, and he had the initials "LM" and "BG" tattooed on his left arm. I have never known nor had any relationship with an individual who had tattoos resembling those described above. In short, I do not know, nor have I ever met Bobby Gilbert.

3) I was at home (the Wicker residence) when Troy Wicker was shot to death, and saw the individual who shot him. That individual was Thomas Arthur, not Bobby Gilbert. I hired and paid money to Thomas Arthur, not Bobby Gilbert, to kill Troy Wicker. Thomas Arthur entered mine and Troy's home and shot and killed Troy Wicker. I did not hire Bobby Gilbert to kill Troy Wicker, he was not at our home on the morning of the murder, and he was not involved in, and certainly did not participate in, Troy Wicker's death.

4) I have also been informed that Bobby Gilbert claims that we were engaged in sexual intercourse at my house between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on the morning of the murder. Because Arthur killed Troy Wicker before 9:00 a.m., the house would have been full of police at the time that Gilbert alleges that we were engaging in sexual intercourse.

5) Sherrie Stone, Thomas Arthur's daughter, has visited me and pressured me to falsely accuse Jack Jessup of committing Troy's murder. She told me that, if I recanted my testimony and falsely state that Arthur is

innocent, Arthur could sue the State of Alabama for a wrongful conviction a receive millions of dollars in damages. She further told me that if I would falsely allege that Arthur is innocence, Arthur would pay me 20% of any judgment he recovered. I will not lie to aid Arthur false claims of innocence or to help him sue the State.

6) To the best of my recollection, I have never met anyone named Jack Jessup. In any event, Jack Jessup did not murder Troy Wicker, Thomas Arthur did.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct, and have nothing further to say at this point.
